WHAT IS STOMACH CANCER?

Stomach cancer, also called gastric cancer, is a cancer that starts in the stomach. Stomach cancers tend to develop slowly over many years. Before a true cancer develops, pre-cancerous changes often occur in the inner lining (mucosa) of the stomach. These early changes rarely cause symptoms and therefore often go undetected.


Other symptoms that can occur include the following:

- · A sense of fullness, even after a small meal
- · Nausea and/or vomiting
- · Loss of appetite and/or weight loss
- · Swelling of the abdomen
- · Unexplained tiredness or weakness
- · Blood in vomit
- · Black-coloured faeces

Some factors that put people at a higher risk of stomach cancer are:

- Smoking
- · Age over 50
- Being male stomach cancers are more common in men than in women
- · Infection with the bacteria Helicobacter pylori
- A diet high in smoked, pickled and salted foods and low in fresh fruit and vegetables
- · A family history of stomach cancer
- · Partial gastrectomy for ulcer disease (after about 20 years)
- · Inheriting a genetic change, that causes the bowel disorders

STAGES OF STOMACH CANCER



The most common form of diagnosing stomach cancer is by having a Gastroscopy.

The main treatment of stomach cancer is having a total or partial gastrectomy or removal of the stomach.

Your treatment team may include the following:

- A gastroenterologist who diagnoses and treats diseases of the gastrointestinal tract
- Medical oncologist who prescribes the course of chemotherapy
- Radiation oncologist who prescribes the course of radiation therapy
- Cancer nurse
- Other health professionals such as a dietician, physiotherapist, social worker or counsellor


